

Rowing weekend on the Danube from 04 or 05 to 07 October

Our trip on Lake Starnberg is cancelled for this year. We had to suspend it, because on the last weekend of September, which was originally scheduled, the Roseninselachter Regatta will take place on Lake Starnberg. Another appointment failed due to Hubert's busy schedule.



Due to the great interest in pre-registration, we didn't want to cancel the event without substitution. And so we picked up Paul Geisenhofer's idea and follow him to the Danube on the first weekend of October 2018!

By chance (!) the Donauruderclub Deggendorf organizes its traditional "Wanderruderregatta" from Straubing to Deggendorf on Saturday, October 6th. If you want to take part in this regatta, please indicate when registering - there are still two interested parties missing for the first IFoRR boat.

The "Regatta" will be 36 km - no panic, the Danube is not jammed between Straubing and Vilshofen. Ranking is based on the Welser system, i. e. there is a women's and age bonus on the rowing time.

All the other participants can start the day more calmly and row the course without timekeeping, but with any number of breaks and visits to the beer garden.

We receive boats from the Regensburg Rowing Club of 1890 e. V. (RRK). They must come to Straubing. This can be done either on a trailer with the boats for the regatta. Or we transfer the boats on Friday, October 5th from Regensburg to Straubing on the waterway.

Those who think this is a good idea should come to Straubing on Thursday evening.

The distance from Deggendorf to Vilshofen on Sunday is somewhat shorter, so that there is still enough time for returning the boats before going home.

We stay in Straubing. There we will select a hotel as soon as the approximate number of participants has been determined. For that reason and to inform the RRK in good time, I ask you to register early.

As in the past year, there will be an additional program for non rowers.
